How to Apply

Completed applications must be submitted to the EGCA office **no later than March 31, 2010.**

- Applicants must submit a copy of their most recent high school or college transcript.

How Applications Are Judged

Selections will be based on overall worthiness of the applicant. The EGCA Scholarship Selection Committee will consider scholastic standing, community service, extra-curricular activities, career goals, and all information submitted with the application. Finalists will be invited to a competition and personal interview with the Scholarship Selection Committee, and be asked to write a brief essay on an industry topic given that day.

The date and time of the competition will be determined by the Selection Committee. Once determined, the students selected to attend the competition will be advised of the date and time. **Applicants selected to attend the competition must appear in person on the day of the competition.**

Award Notification

3. If you could have dinner with one person, living or deceased, who would you select and why?
4. Why do you believe you would be a deserving candidate to receive the EGCA scholarship for which you are applying?
